### Enrollment

**Total Students (October 2011):** 301

**Grades (2013-2014):** K-5 (This school currently serves PK)

**Kindergarten Admissions Priorities:** This school has kindergarten seats for applicants from District 13 and District 15. Approximately one-third of available kindergarten seats will be offered to residents of District 13. Approximately two-thirds will be offered to residents of District 15. For 35% of its seats, the school will prioritize first English Language Learners, then students eligible for free and reduced lunch.<sup>^</sup> For each district and the prioritized applicant groups, the following admissions priority structure will be applied. Out-of-district applicants who do not fall into groups 2 or 4 below will be offered seats only after all District 13 and 15 applicants have been accommodated.

1. In-district siblings
2. Out-of-district siblings
3. In-district current pre-k students\*
4. Out-of-district current pre-k students\*
5. Other in-district applicants

\*This priority is pending approval by the Panel for Educational Policy

<sup>^</sup> In this case, English Language Learner (ELL) is defined as a student who comes from a home in which a language other than English is spoken most of the time by siblings, parents/caregivers, and other relatives. As a result, the child shows greater dominance in speaking and listening (as well as reading and writing if age-appropriate) in the home language than in English. A student's eligibility for free and reduced lunch is based upon family income and size; for specific criteria please see Chancellor's Regulation A-810.

**Special Education Services:** This school will provide students with disabilities the supports and services indicated in their IEPs.

**ELL Programs:** ESL; French Dual Language, Spanish Dual Language
